But in the past few weeks, the group has solidified its commitment to nurturing and maintaining a strong Jaycee heritage in Lee County.

We learned in March that Council agreed to pay for a new roof to replace the rotted and leaky one we inherited. Then in early April, it sent over a tree-removal services to cut down and remove several large trees that were damaging the Hut's foundation and enhancing the roof problems.

In total, this assistance has saved our chapter more than \$6,000! That means we can focus on investing the funds we raise right back into the community.
